- FVHDA** reserves the right to combine, cancel or divide events. FVHDA reserves the right to move start times and/or classes around as seemed necessary.
- Dancers must present a current SOBHD registration card prior to receiving awards.
- Competitors dance only in their respective age group, based on their age on the day of the competition.
- Dancers will compete in reverse order of registration.
- Competitor numbers will be assigned with receipt of registration and will be picked up at competition check-in (they will not be mailed). Numbers will be assigned high to low with high numbers being last to dance.
- Competitors must be on hand when their event is called or forfeit entry in that dance.
- Judges decisions are final. Any protest must be written, signed and submitted to the Competition Secretary accompanied by a \$25.00 fee before the end of the competition. If the protest is sustained the fee will be returned.
- All premiers** will dance short steps except for the jig challenge.
