Championship Rules and Regulations

1. The FVHDA Open Championship is sanctioned and conducted under the rules and regulations of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing.
2. The order to dance will be pre-drawn using a specially designed computer program.
3. Age is determined as of April 28th, 2018.
4. Dancers must perform the 2018 Championship Set Steps.
5. Premier 15 years & under will receive medals. Prize Money will be awarded to Premier Dancers 16 years & over.

Note: Competition rules 6-13 listed below also apply to the Championship.

Competition Rules and Regulations

1. The competition will be governed by the rules and regulations of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing. Dancers must comply with the SOBHD Code of Conduct. Failure to do so will result in the dancer being reported to the SOBHD.
2. Dancers will compete in inverse order of registration. First to enter is last to dance.
3. Age is determined as of the day of the event – April 28th 2018.
4. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete/cancel classes according to the entries received. Classes will be determined on receipt of entries.
5. Open Awards: Medals and Aggregate awards to Pre-Premier dancers and Premier dancers 15 years and under. Premier dancers aged 16 and Over will receive cash awards. Primary dancers will be awarded medals and participation awards.
6. Confirmation will be sent by email. Numbers will not be sent out but will be available for collection on the day.
7. All competitors must present their current 2018 SOBHD registration cards to pick up their numbers and to receive awards. Charges will apply for forgotten cards. All competitors must remain in costume for all award presentations.
8. All status changes must be reported no later than 6 days prior to the competition. Please contact our Competition Secretary: Carla Kelly at kelly.fvhda@gmail.com.
9. Competitors must be on hand when their event is called or forfeit entry in that dance.
10. Dancers must fill in for the Reel if asked. Dancers filling in for the Reel must dance the entire dance.
11. The judge's decision is final. Protests must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the competition secretary before the end of the Competition or Championship day. Protests must be accompanied by a fee of \$35.00, refundable if sustained.
12. Please make all **cheques and money orders payable to FVHDA**. Postdated cheques will NOT be accepted. No refunds will be considered. US cheques are accepted at par (1:1).
13. Dancers and parents must respect to ScotDance Canada risk management guidelines, SOBHD code of Ethics and the FVHDA Codes of conduct all times. Dancers must be dressed appropriately at all times.
